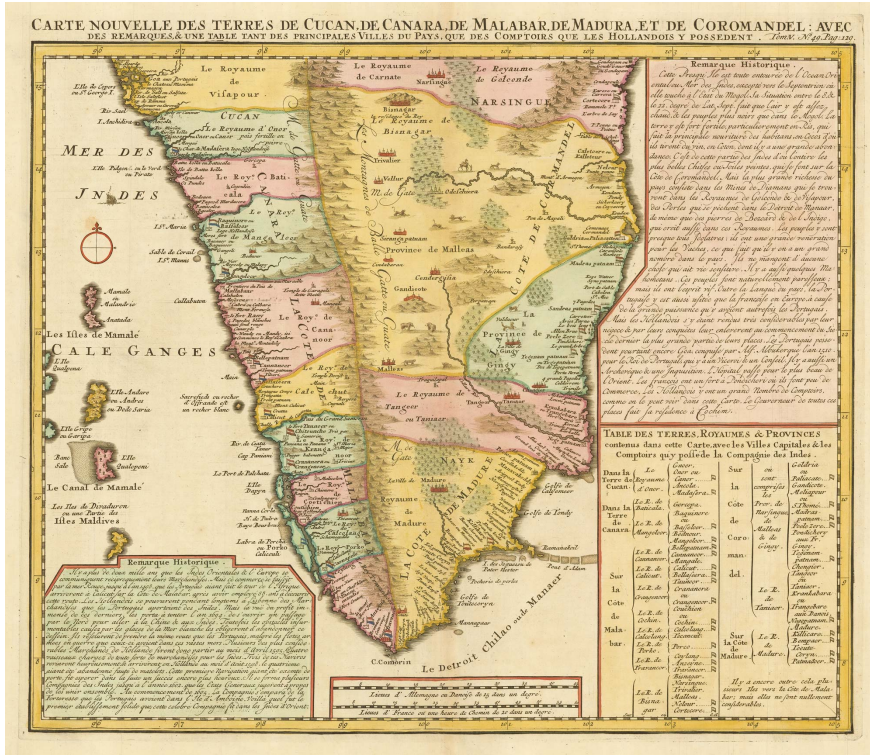




A French map of Southern India
