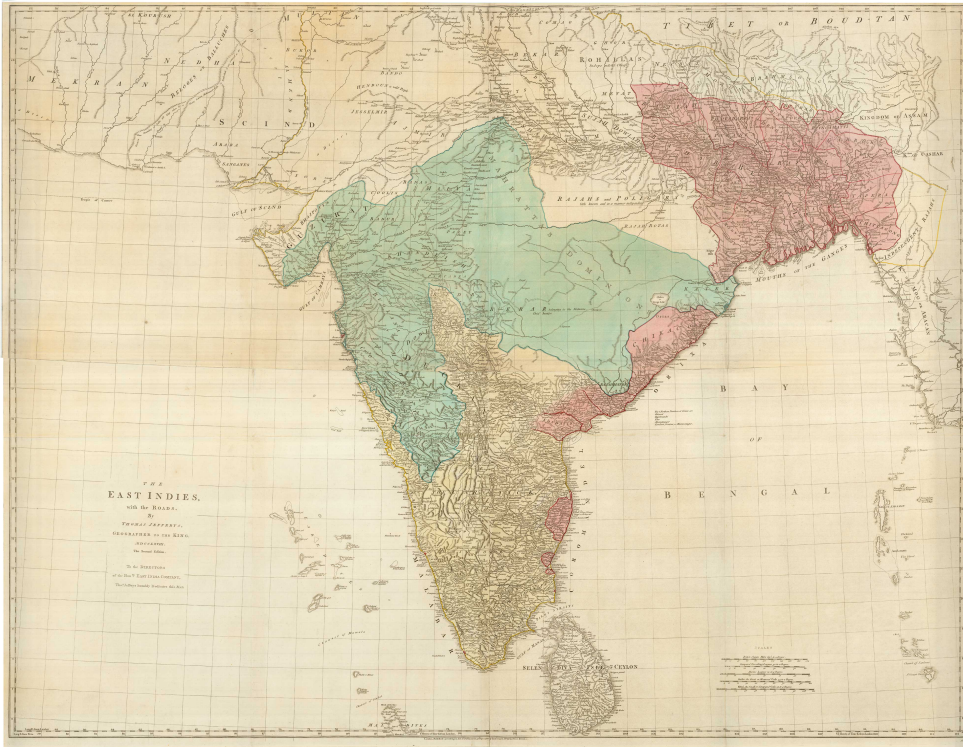




A four-sheet map of India in the 18th century
